

## **Lab Work**

Per Anthem:

1. If blood is drawn and read in an in-network physician's office, it will fall under the \$30/\$50 office co-pay and there will be not additional charges.
2. If blood is drawn at the physician's office and sent out to Lab Corp (A free standing in-network lab), it will again fall under the \$30/\$50 office co-pay and there will be no additional charges.
3. If the doctor send you to Lab Corp (A free standing in-network lab), then you will pay a \$30/\$50 co-pay and there will be no additional charges.
4. **If blood is drawn in an in-network physician's office but then is sent out to be processed by an in-network hospital affiliated lab such as Southeast or St. Francis, then the lab charges will be subject to your Deductible and co-insurance.**
5. **If the blood is drawn at an in-network hospital or hospital affiliated lab, then the charges will be subject to the deductible and co-insurance.**

## **RADIOLOGY**

If you have a simple x-ray performed and read in the physician's office . . . ex: broken finger, then this would be covered under the \$30/\$50 office co-pay.

Any other x-rays, images, ultrasounds etc. with the exception of preventative covered mammograms, etc., will be subject to the deductible and co-insurance.
