Discipline Policy

We look forward to a great summer, filled with fun and learning. Therefore, it is critical that all students follow the rules so that all students are safe and able to enjoy the program. Discipline guidelines used during the regular school year will be enforced during the summer program.

Disciplinary action, including dismissal from the program, will be taken when rules are violated.

In addition to the regular discipline guidelines, JMS summer program will also utilize the following:

- There is zero tolerance for fighting or threats of violence. Students who fight or make threatening remarks may be dismissed from the program immediately.
- Cell phones must be turned OFF from 7:30am-12:00pm. Any student found speaking or texting on a cell phone during these hours may be dismissed from the program. The only exception is if a teacher gives a student permission.
- Unlike during the regular school year, Jackson R2 does not provide alternate programs in the summer for students who exhibit behavior problems. Students may be dismissed from the program if they violate school rules.

Discipline Procedures:

1. Teacher will conference with the student and contact parent/guardian regarding discipline issue.
2. Teacher will refer student to Assistant Principal. He will contact parent/guardian and warn the student that the next violation may result in dismissal from the program.
3. Assistant Principal will conference with student and may, at his discretion, dismiss the student from the program.
 - Severe circumstances may be dealt with on an individual basis.

One hour Enrichment Courses

Popping with Printing - Mrs. Parker

This course will introduce students to a range of print making processes. Students will be able to print carver their own linoleum and print your own pattern on fabric! Experience the true "WOW" factor of using a 3D printer and actually creating an object from the 3D printer that you get to take home for your very own! Students will also be creating 3 dimensional object with felt. On top of all this, there will be plenty of other fun and artsy projects!

Creative Corner – Mrs. Ford

Students will become familiar with the computer program Microsoft Publisher. They will work on several projects that they can add a creative touch to just by becoming familiar with this program. Some projects the students will be exposed to will be: news articles, flyers, business cards, restaurant menus and more. After taking this class students will feel more comfortable and confident when adding a more creative style to their school work. Their keyboarding and basic computer skills will improve as well. From Page to Stage- Mr. Clubbs

Action! Student in this class will read, write, and perform drama! We will explore basic acting techniques, think like a director, and craft like a playwright.

Clash of the Ancient Cultures – Mr. Brown

Do you want to live it up like the knights of the round table?...Well, live it up like they did with a modern day twist! How about building a model of a real Medieval Castle, taking the scooter jousting challenge, creating your own personal coat of arms, building a pyramid with hieroglyphics, becoming a real knight through a formal dubbing ceremony? Participating in the annual Greek Olympic Games...will you bring glory to your city-state of Athens or Sparta by winning the games? Well, if you think you have what it takes, then Medieval Mania with Mr. Brown is the class for you!

Pedaling Pioneer: Iceland Adventure - Mr. Holloway and Mr. Haertling

This course will blend a first hand adventure of Iceland with in-class discovery of the interesting places, animals, and history of Iceland. During this class Mr. Haertling will travel to Iceland and tour the island. They will video document this expedition with the help of a drone. The drone will allow students an opportunity to experience Iceland's breathtaking vistas from a different perspective. Mr. Haertling will also communicate with classes and describe their experiences. Students will be able to send the explorers questions that they might have about current locations or upcoming stops on the trek. In class, Mr. Holloway will provide enrichment lessons and activities that will help further student understanding and knowledge of Iceland's unique geographic and cultural features.

Tree-D Sculpture - Mr. Kohm

This summer you have a chance to ART **BIG**. We are talkin sculptures the size of you! You want to make a giant sculpture of a jellyfish? We're doin it! Massive paper mache sculptures? We got it! It's go big or go home in the art room this summer and we choose **BIG**.

Projects include:

- A small ceramic sculpture made from recycled clay
- A large scale collaborative paper mache sculptures made from reused news paper
- A sculpture made of plastic bags and bottles

Savage Survivalist - Mr. Huffman

If you were stranded in the woods for two days would you know what to do? In this class we will learn types of trees and what they are used for, different types of campfires and when to use them, shelter making, how to properly and safely cook on a campfire, and how to use the resources nature provides you. Weather permitting we will be outdoors practicing these skills.

One hour Strategy Courses

Strategies in Reading and Writing—Mrs. McBryde and Mrs. Hochmuth.....1 hour class

Strategies in Math—Mrs. Mcelroy and Mrs. Guyot.....1 hour class

This course is designed for students who would benefit from extra attention on math skills. Students will have the opportunity to work in a small group setting, enabling them to receive direct, focused instruction. This course requires your child's teacher or principal approval.
