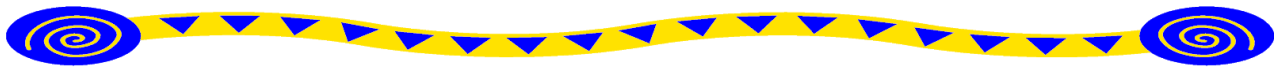


Positive POW-WOW

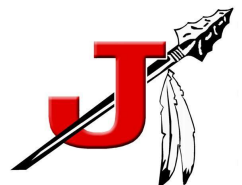
