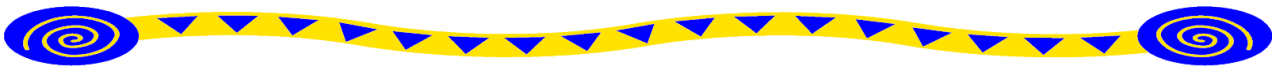


# Positive Parent POW-WOW

- Mar. 11-15 = I can ask permission to leave the playground area (Playground).
- Mar. 18-22 = I can ask go to my class spot and sit and ask permission to leave that Spot (Arrival).
- Mar. 25-29 = I can use appropriate language, voice level, and kind words (Arrival & Dismissal).



## Mrs. Criddle's Corner

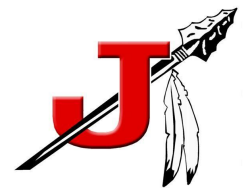

Dear Families,

We are continuing to work on our skills and do our best to achieve our goals. I am happy to report that we have seen gains in the percent of students reading on or above grade level. However, we are still continuing to push every child to their potential. In order to do this, we need your help. We strongly suggest that you ensure your student is here every day and on time to receive instruction. If possible, please schedule appointments and vacations when school is out. In most classes, reading instruction begins promptly in their classrooms at 8:00 each morning. Teachers are working diligently to teach the curriculum while meeting the students at their learning level. We need your help reinforcing this at home. You may help your student learn their math facts, practice word wall words, conduct fun science experiments, read books, play learning games, or complete suggested activities sent home by the teacher. Our goal is to end the year with every child reading at their grade level and above. Please know that if you have any questions, you can write a note or call us to get the information you need.

Our February school-wide total attendance was 92.47%. Mrs. Harbison's 2nd grade class had the highest attendance in February at 94.43%.
