Important - Students will be in attendance 16 school days. **Due to the short attendance period and the offering of** credit during this time, required attendance is 93% of scheduled class time for receiving credit. This means the student can not miss more than one session (4 hours total).

Normal school rules apply during summer school. The following frequently need to be clarified: Students should dress appropriately (no short shorts & no tank tops).

Each session represents one semester of credit equivalent to a ½ credit towards graduation. All course offerings are subject to change/cancellation depending on enrollment numbers and instructor availability. For this reason, it is important to enroll early!

Schedules will be e-mailed in mid-May confirming your student's placement for summer school. If you do not receive a schedule then your student is likely on a waiting list for a class and will be notified when a spot becomes available.
